## Background

DETI is planning to introduce a Northern Ireland Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) scheme subject to the appropriate legislation being approved by the NI Assembly. The Gas and Electricity Market Authority (Ofgem) will administer the NI RHI including dealing with applications, accrediting installations, making incentive payments and monitoring compliance with the rules and conditions of the scheme.

## Stakeholder Events

In addition, DETI is hosting two stakeholder events in order to gather views on these proposals. These will take place in Belfast (Netherleigh House) on Tuesday 25 September at 2pm and Cookstown (Burnavon Arts & Cultural Centre) on Wednesday 26 September at 10.45am.
