We will be doing our own separate research into the impact of the EMR package on NI (something the EMR proposals do not) and this, together with the outworkings of the DECC proposals, will help inform how we ensure continued renewables incentivisation. This will only become clear once the DECC proposals are firmed up in the White Paper planned for Spring (probably May).
