I have just read the Minister's Press Release (23 March 2010) on the passing of and i have a few queries i would like to run past you.

Contacts we had spoken to within DETI had told us that the Minister would be keeping the door open on Anaerobic Digestion and that she would invite input from several bodies on the case for level of support open to AD.

During the debate yesterday, Minister Foster did mention that DETI "would shortly launch a public call for evidence on the costs of AD". Also, that she would be inviting evidence from those with an interest in AD"

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Whilst this was encouraging, i was a bit surprised that there was no mention of AD in the latest press release. Could you let me know what the current position is in relation to AD and the timetable ahead for future UFU involvement.
