Further to our call, the attached shows where we are with biomass installations on the rented farms. The standalone contract I proposed and implemented (with Debbie) has given the Landlord's confidence to invest, and without the RHI they wouldn't have done this. The business was pushing to have biomass installed and benefit from the wider benefits and hence I believe this has successful. By year end we should have 76 boilers covering 86 shed. With 28 sheds already operating, and many more due over the next 2 crops this initiative is significantly more successful than then ESCO deal across the company owned farms in bringing benefit to Moy Park.
