Concentrating on growing chicken better rather than farming RHI's – which this could become if we are not mindful!

From an installation perspective we would want to cover

Gas Back Up – why its required what is best and what needs to be considered at installation

RHI/Cost - paperwork and record keeping what is required and why necessary to monitor boiler efficiency

Fuel – source and issues with Pellet & Chip

Maintenance – cost and interval

Back Up – testing back up every crop and recording

Husbandry

Your guys will have views on this with the tiny talk, pre heating, monitoring, linking with ventilation etc

Don't propose this is a big document – one pager – but it may get some points across and be sure we tell all growers the same story and get them to try and start this the correct way!
