Typically for a retro fit site with 2 houses

Hot Water Heating in the house £40k
Biomass Boiler with store £60K

Budget £105K for 2 houses

Moy Park will support the Hot Water as we believe it is the best for bird performance AHP at 100% over 10 years - £4k per year quarterly Biomass – supported by RHI and Moy Park don't share RHI so well-funded out of RHI

In the case of an older house without windows we will not support Biomass but if they fit windows then yes

So some customers will need to get windows included

Typical cost £15 - 20 per house we will fund 115% over 5 years plus they get an extra £7.89 or £10 per thou once windows fitted –
