Hi Gareth

Farmers have clear & stringent temperature guidelines that they should be following starting at 33C at day 1 & dropping to 21 – 22C at day 28 – 30. I am amazed that farmers are heating above these temperature just because they have Bio Mass and receive RHI payments to heat houses as this would be a false economy on two counts: -

1. Running bio mass heating right up to catching will require fans to be constantly on to distribute the heat & ventilation

running excessively to maintain optimum temperatures as the birds grow therefore a false economy resulting in massively elevated electric bills

2. If farmers run above optimum recommended temperatures bird performance will be adversely affected drastically reducing their bird income.

If catchers do come across houses which are running excessively warm then we need to know so take a note of who they are & through your or Nigel report to the Technical advisory teams
