1. RHI – David Mark – RHI discussion – Bona Fide need for heat and legitimate use. MP would support an audit procedure for heat use on broiler farms. If potential wastage was eliminated then the scheme would come in on budget. This would ensure that MP growers could be sure of current and future use. Committee have concerns over putting a figure on RHI use to officials and are currently unwilling to ask growers to supply RHI figures to Moy Park.

1. RHI – David Mark – RHI discussion – Discussion on how “responsible use of heat” may be gauged. MP would like to have the general data to be able to confirm our view that the growers involved in the scheme have a bona fide use and are using heat responsibly. Indications are that if potential wastage across all users was eliminated then the scheme could come in on budget. Continuation of the scheme we recognise is important for growers. Committee have concerns over putting a figure on RHI use to officials and are currently unwilling to ask growers to supply RHI figures to Moy Park.
