This tweet recognises the main area of concern for the program – that is the suspicion that many “drying services” type applications are “gaming” the system.



His point here is that the audits will have a “business case” aspect and evidence will be required for heat – which is what WE ASKED FOR!



He is well informed and he is supporting the “responsible use” position we have been advocating.



However since Friday we now for the first have a limited public data set to know what is happening it is limited only 40% of Ltd applicants however Moy Park it represents **only 14%** of our applications – so it may even be a **favourable** bias in what we have now for our data! Even with that he is starting to see the issues that we need to be aware of!



On a separate point he addresses the Peak issue fairly I feel and gets to the heart of this issue. This relates to the discussions we had with officials on the 2nd July when it was clear the change was coming – and we have other info that all the trade were told at that time in briefings.
