Thanks for sight of this draft. No particular issues with the content but I was speaking to Stuart and we wonder about the merits of quoting the cap limit in the worked example. Would it be possible to quote a lower tier 2 figure, or perhaps just quote the 1314 peak hours figures in the example and indicate that any additional heat required above this up to the cap limit would be paid at 1.5 pence per kWh?

I know farmers will do the maths anyway but quoting the maximum figures is perhaps not giving out the correct message.
