Apologies for taking so long to reply I have had some pressing Ministerial issues which took up a lot of my time recently

EPD remain of the view that in order to achieve and maintain EU air quality limit values the RHI standard should be the same for NI as part of a suite of measures aimed and meeting EU air quality limit values. We see no good reason to depart from that view given we are already seeking a time extension for compliance with the NO2 limit value to 2015 and infraction proceedings are expected to commence this autumn as compliance is predicted beyond 2015 . We also have reported exceedences of PAH EU limit value of which wood/wood pellets is a significant contributor. Therefore any weakening of standards will have long term negative air quality impacts.
