Seamus

As discussed, I was speaking to David Mark from Moy Park about our plans for Phase 2 of the Non-domestic RHI scheme. I outlined our proposal to increase the maximum boiler size for the 6.3p biomass tariff from 99 to 199KW like GB which he welcomed.

I asked him how many Broiler Houses would be coming forward for the RHI in the coming months. He confirmed that there could be up to 200 new broiler houses coming forward in 2015, each with 99KW boilers. Assuming around 350MWh / boiler / yr this equates to an additional 70GWh of renewable heat (or £4.4M/yr of RHI funding). We will need to liaise with DECC about future RHI funding asap.
