It is difficult to be certain as to when a policy decision will be published but as you know as part of the RHI Phase 2 proposals, DETI is considering extending the 6.3p/kWh biomass tariff to plants up to and including 199kW and introducing a new district heating tariff of 7.0p/kWh for plants of 200KW or larger. Subject to financial and legislative approvals, it is hoped that the Phase 2 proposals will be introduced in October 2015.

In terms of your legacy query eligible renewable heating technologies installed and commissioned from 1 Sep 2010 will be eligible to apply for the new tariffs provided they're not already accredited on the RHI scheme. However, the tariff period for an eligible plant will commence once it has been accredited onto the RHI scheme. No payments shall be backdated to the commissioning date.
