- Biomass or bioliquid CHP,(new systems), all sizes 3.5 pence per kWh
- Biomass or bioliquid CHP, (conversions from fossil fuels), all sizes, 1.7 pence per kWh

Good morning Seamus,

I am now in charge of RHI at Action Renewables since Fergal Hegarty's departure. I wanted to ask you a question about small scale CHP in NI in terms of claiming ROCs and RHI. I received a query from a company interested in installing biomass (woodchip) CHP that can deliver 90 kWt heat and 30 kWe

As far as I'm aware this would not be eligible for RHI payments at the moment. In terms of ROCs my understanding is that this would be considered under the band of 'dedicated biomass' and eligible for 1.5 ROCs.

If you could confirm if this is accurate or inaccurate that would be much appreciated.
