As you are aware from our previous conversations the phase 2 extension of RHI has been deferred pending confirmation on future budgets and it is unlikely that phase 2 will now be in place before late 2016. At this point we have no plans to include tiering of the district heating tariff proposal but of course we can't say for certain on this until the final policy has been agreed.

Will this also be a two tiered tariff?
