Nothing official as yet but as we discussed in our recent meeting DETI is currently looking at potential changes to the non domestic RHI in the autumn as part of the outworking of the phase 2 review consultation from late 2013. The proposals under consideration concern a new tariff for combined heat and power to coincide with the changes to the ROC's and also cost control measures around biomass banding and possible tariff tiers.

I would hope to have more definite news over the coming weeks and will keep you in the loop on any updates.
