By way of update I can confirm that DETI is currently looking at potential changes to the non domestic RHI in the autumn as part of the outworking of the phase 2 review consultation from late 2013. The proposals under consideration concern a new tariff for combined heat and power to coincide with the changes to the ROC's and also cost control measures around biomass banding and possible tariff tiers.

However, the other proposals that were under consideration including the biomethane injection issue have been deferred for now pending confirmation on budget going forward. It is likely to be the middle of 2016 at the earliest before the rest of phase 2 is taken forward.

I will keep you in the loop as we move forward and up to speed on any developments.
