May I thank you for affording me the time today to enjoy a wide ranging and pointed conversation discussing the impact of the recent cessation of the RHI scheme in NI and its consequences.

We also discussed the scale of the industry, the requirements that local companies increasingly must fulfil to meet their Renewable Energy obligations with customers and what can be done to create a Renewables Agenda for a DETI Minister in a new Assembly in Q2.

As we discussed the next step forward is to meet with some of your team to start putting ideas together to design a replacement proposal that more closely matches the scheme in the UK but allows much greater scrutiny and control. I will take your lead in the timing of that process.

There are other angles to look at for funding a scheme and I am happy to facilitate some of those conversations.

May I thank you once again for your time and I would be delighted to assist you in the reshaping of Renewables policy in NI of which Biomass is the key component.
