**CLOSURE OF THE NI RENEWABLE HEAT INCENTIVE (RHI)**

Your email of 25 February 2016 to Patsy McGlone, MLA and Adrian Cochrane – Watson, MLA concerning RHI closure refers.

The Enterprise Trade and Investment Committee, (ETI), noted your email at its meeting on 1 March 2016 and agreed to pass your query to the Department for a direct response.

I can confirm that all renewable heating installations that were completed and commissioned and applied for prior to 11.59 pm on Monday 29 February 2016 are eligible for RHI and will be processed by Ofgem in the normal way.
