Thank you for quick response to my tweet.

Earlier last year I was persuaded to go for a ground source heat pump connected to underfloor heating. With the grant etc it still worked out slightly dearer than conventional boiler system but I reckoned it was a small price to pay to be more 'green'.

I am at the stage where the ground source pipes are all laid and all pipes in house. Just awaiting to connect the heat pump etc but had held off until new electric connection is installed. (another issue- NIE take ages). SoI am at point of no return but obviously application not submitted yet as system is not signed off. No RHI will add a significant unexpected cost to the bill

Hopefully you can retain the domestic payments even if the commercial

systems are proving too expensive.
