"When are the changes to the Renewable Heat Incentive due to take effect and is this defined by the date of installation of the boiler?"

the following response has been drafted - I'd be grateful for clearance:

"The latest assessment on the introduction of the non domestic RHI changes is that they will be in place from 11 November 2015.

"Boiler installations completed, commissioned, meeting the RHI eligibility criteria and having applications submitted to Ofgem prior to the 11 November will be at the current RHI rates and those after this date will be under the new arrangements."
