Corporate Risk Register - RHI Form of Words

Original text was supplied by Energy Division. Finance Division suggested changes have been tracked:

DFP has declined retrospective approval for new commitments under this scheme from 1 April 2015 to 28 October 2015. ~~However, discussions are ongoing with DFP about the issue.~~

Because the AME allocation to the Scheme has been capped under the 2015 CSR there is likely to be a shortfall which will have to be funded from Resource DEL. HMT is, however, still considering the funding issue. Discussions ongoing between DFP and HMT iro future RHI funding following SR announcement on 25 Nov 2015. Options on the future of both RHI schemes have been put to the Minister but if reductions in funding are confirmed, work will have to commence as soon as possible to close both the Domestic and Non-Domestic RHI Schemes to new applicants from 1 April 2016.
