Alan / David,

We had a teleconference this morning with Ofgem and the issue of 'building' v 'site' again was raised and whilst we advised that you were still considering the matter it has become apparent that it will be too problematic, in terms of

timing, to have any departure from the GB regs on this matter. Apologies in advance, however I would be grateful if you could revert to the original definition of 'building' and replace references to the newly defined 'site' with 'building', i.e. return to the GB understanding of building.

This remains a matter we wish to consider in the future and will gather the views of stakeholders during the consultation on the guidance document. Therefore I would be grateful if any considerations or views on this matter (definitions and how it might be dealt with in the future) that you have already undertaken since yesterday's meeting are provided alongside the updated draft regs when ready.

If you require further clarification please let me know.
