To whom it concerns.

In December 2015 we the above named company had planned to install a biomass heating system using the RHI grant scheme and a carbon trust loan. We operate four connected workshops (See attached photos) repairing Commercial and motor sport vehicles and use in excess of 22000 litres of heating oil annually. We had our workshops assessed in order to qualify for the above scheme and then continued with the process of purchasing the heating system from Hegan Biomass.

On the 22nd Dec 2015 we paid a £10,000 deposit for the heating system and after going through the whole process of the application and successfully obtaining a loan offer from the carbon trust we then found that the NI Assembly had prematurely cancelled the scheme at the start of February. This left us with no option but to cancel our order with Hegan Biomass.

Then after a few days the NI Assembly had a change of heart and extended the scheme until the end of February. After hearing this we again contacted Hegan Biomass and reinstated the order. We then found that the manufacturer had sold the machine originally earmarked for us to another customer. A replacement machine was ordered but will not be dispatched from the manufacturer in Germany until the 3rd of March which is outside the extended deadline.

Our machine would have been installed and operational in mid February 2016 had the executive had not prematurely cancelled the scheme. Through no fault of our own we are now unable to reduce our carbon foot print and we therefore appeal to the minister for a special case extension to the scheme.

Please see attached pro forma invoice from Hegan Biomass proving that we would have complied with The scheme regulations and time frame had the executive not pulled the plug early.
