The Energy Efficiency Loan Scheme (administered on behalf of Invest NI by Carbon Trust) is currently still open to the wider business base.

The scheme provides 0% interest loans of between £3,000 and £400,000 to help Northern Ireland businesses to install new energy saving equipment to help reduce operating costs. The savings made on energy bills should offset the loan repayments, meaning the energy efficient equipment should help to pay for itself. Annual energy savings are then recurrent for the lifetime of the equipment. The size of loan available will depend on the energy saving potential of any particular project (£1000 offered for every 1.5t of CO2 savings).
