Just in terms of finalising the report, grateful if you would consider a couple of issues;

- In terms of the role of NIAUR, it is still a possibility that DETI will retain the enforcement function rather than transferring to NIAUR, therefore grateful if you could revise where the report refers to NIAUR to say DETI/NIAUR.
- Also, as discussed with Catherine last week, grateful if you revise wording around the £1m legal contingency to make clear that DETI will retain the risk and therefore hold adequate legal budget, in the same way DETI will hold necessary contingency budget for the development stage (i.e. this doesn't need to be transferred to Ofgem).

Once this is finalised we can make payment on this feasibility study.
