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Peter,

Sorry for the delayed response.

The application submission date is the most recent date the applicant has submitted their RHI application back to Ofgem following a query

The original submission date is the date the applicant first submitted their RHI application to Ofgem

The effective accreditation date can be one of the following;

- The date for opening meter readings within the submitted application for accreditation
- The date of commissioning;
- The date that you satisfy Ofgem that you meet the eligibility criteria.

The date of accreditation is the date from which RHI payments will be calculated. The date of accreditation is the later of either the date on which an application (which is complete and which demonstrates the eligibility of an installation) is received by Ofgem and we are satisfied that the application was properly made, or the date the installation was first commissioned.

As you stated, usually the effective date and accreditation date are the same unless there is a significant change to one's application.

Can ask you to clarify the differences between the columns entitled, "application submission date"; "original submission date"; "application effective date" and "accreditation date"?

Can you just briefly explain how these dates are assessed, for example in most cases the application effective date and accreditation date are the same (except for NIRH Personal information redacted by the RHI inquiry) and these dates tend to be after the original submission date but before the application submission date.

Grateful if you would provide a brief explanation on how these dates refer to the application /

installation.

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
