Good afternoon Marc

I wonder if I could trouble you for some more information about the NIRHI. We are currently working towards some changes to the NIRHI effective from 4 November 2015 and one of the things we are doing is introducing an annual cap of 400,000kWh for new biomass installations going forward.

Our evidence suggests that this allowance should cover the heating requirements of most installations but we are wondering if there are any current installations, (from 1 November 2012 to the present), receiving annual payments for in excess of 400,000kWh, if this information is available.

It would be most helpful to us if this could be provided.
