Dear Mr Cullen,

Thanks for your query regarding the Northern Ireland Renewable Heat Incentive (NIRHI).

In order to be able to apply for multiple installations located in a single site, the following criteria has to be met for each heating system:

- They are completely independent heating systems (no connection exists in between elements of heating systems)
- There is a separate generation plant serving heat for each of the heating systems
- There are separate metering arrangements for each heating system

According to the details you have provided it seems that your clients would meet the criteria to be able to apply for multiple installation. However, please note that when submitting an application for accreditation for each of the heating systems they will need to provide evidence (e.g. schematic diagrams showing all existing elements of the heating system, evidence of existence/purchase of each boiler, site layout etc) to prove that these heating systems are completely independent from each other (they don't form part of the heating system) and it will have to satisfy us. As all the plants would belong to the same client, a single account would be set from which multiple applications could be submitted, all being able to be under the same address.

Further to this, they will also need to provide evidence of the non-domestic status of the plants. They will also have to meet all the rest of the eligibility criteria under the NIRHI non-domestic scheme.
