Dear Sir/Madam

I enclose for relaying before the Assembly a copy of the above-named Statutory Rule. The Rule is in draft form in accordance with Section 113 of the Energy Act 2011 and is subject to affirmative resolution procedure.

The original Rule was laid on 20 November but a number of minor amendments have been made on the advice of the Examiner of Statutory Rules.

Also enclosed are **6** further copies of the Rule and explanatory memorandum (4 of which should be forwarded to the Departmental Committee, 1 to the Examiner of Statutory Rules and 2 to the Assembly Library. Please advise this Department in due course of the date when the Rule will be considered by the Committee. I am also sending you a separate email with electronic copies of this form, the Rule and the explanatory memorandum.

There have been a number of minor changes to the proposed domestic RHI scheme since the SL1 was submitted to the Committee, most notably a £500 increase in the proposed cap on annual RHI payments. However, this is not viewed as a substantial policy change.

I will attend when requested, in order to give any further information required by the Committee.
