John, as discussed.

I can confirm that unlike the GB scheme, the NI RHI is targeted towards households and businesses that are off the gas grid and currently using oil, coal or LPG. Both NI RHI schemes are run on a self referral basis, but the RHI tariffs are based on an oil counterfactual which makes the scheme much less attractive to customers on the existing gas network. Our application numbers back this up with only 1.8% (29) of the 1,608 installations incentivised through the domestic RHI scheme switching from natural gas.
