The following are the main points raised by Phil Flanagan and Stephen Agnew which would need to be addressed in oral briefing:

During the original consultation there was a large differential between the GB and NI proposals - Has this been addressed?

Concerned about the apparent protection of Natural Gas to the detriment of Deep Geothermal; and

Wants to see DETI's response to the concerns raised during the consultation.

The Committee are happy to see a RHI for NI but want to be sure it is right for both the consumer and Government.

By not approving the SL1 at this stage the Department will not be delayed as it cannot proceed until EC approval is forthcoming.

Do not feel that the SL1 should be approved until "All the information requested can be provided."
