**PROGRAMME FOR GOVERNMENT REPORTING: COMMITMENT 13**

Following the latest Executive Programme Board meeting, I am writing to inform you that Board members have requested that, from this point forward, DETI does not sub-divide Commitment 13, as has been the practice to date.

Ministers are of the opinion that progress should be measured against the Commitment as a whole, and the separation of the electricity and heat elements of the Commitment should be avoided.

Officials from the Central Programme for Government will implement the necessary changes to the online reporting system in time for the next round of reporting and monitoring.
