Please find attached the RHI report with comments added, I tracked changes and added in suggestions/observations that were specific to the text. In addition to these comments I would like to add.

It was disappointing to see that the report did not include what affect paying for the RHI would have on the consumers not able to partake in the incentive i.e. What affect will increasing the cost of fuel bills will have on fuel poverty in Northern Ireland.

I was also disappointed ACOEM could not have investigated other methods of incentivising renewable heat, I believe the current method proposed for the UK is open to manipulation and to prevent this will require a large administrative exercise. RHI needs to be as transparent and as un-bureaucratic as possible and I don't believe the proposed method can yet achieve these requirements.

Otherwise this was quiet a read and an impressive piece of work.

I look forward to having further input to the RHI if possible.
