Issue:	<p>The Department has successfully put forward a legislative consent motion which allowed for the Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC) to amend their current Energy Bill 2011 that would extend powers for renewable heat, contained within the 2008 Energy Act, to Northern Ireland. DECC are seeking Royal Assent in July 2011 and we can only move forward with the implementation of subordinate legislation once this has been acquired. Once Royal Assent has been obtained, this will allow the Department to proceed and make subordinate legislation for a Renewable Heat strategy in Northern Ireland.</p> <p>The standalone clause, which has been tabled in the 2011 Energy Bill, is attached for your information.</p>
Action required:	Request to draft Northern Ireland Renewable Heat Incentive Regulations. These will be based largely, in the first instance, on the GB equivalent Regulations. These are attached for your information.
Date Required By:	The draft Regulations would be required in time for the Department's consultation on a potential RHI scheme which is due to be launched in early July 2011
