The £6.7 million LASFE AME is useless to us. It is Local Authority Self Financed Expenditure which scores in Other AME. All it allows us to do is to score any expenditure incurred by LAs - which we do anyway.

The Renewable Heat Incentive Scheme - possible to get the AME funding but we would need to run details of the proposed scheme past HMT for them to ensure the proposed outcomes for the NI schemed were similar to those for the GB scheme.
