By way of update, further to this morning's meeting Minister has advised that:

- It is not necessary to embed a DoF economist in the DfE Steering group. It is for DfE to deliver the Scheme;
- The reference to "all RHI costs incurred over business case should be covered by DfE" should be removed as a condition of the scheme.
- Minister has also advised that there is no requirement for details of scheme participants to be published as a condition of approval, rather the benefit of publication in terms of transparency should be made as a contextual point.

My submission and draft letter to Minister recommending approval of the preferred option will reflect the position above.
