As expected, we've been experiencing large volumes of calls this morning following the announcement. Many of the calls have been from suppliers / installers saying that because they've committed orders for boilers that won't be completed in time, this will be enough to be put them into administration. To be fair, many of them were aware closure was imminent but were working to a 31 March deadline not mid February. We still do have the option through the Notice of deferring suspension for a few weeks to try and reduce the impact on the

industry.
