As mentioned yesterday, happy to take this on. Of course, appreciate that we cannot move on this until we get the green light from DETI. Certainly we will need to hit the ground running here. Staffing wise It would be good to get a feel as to where the 33% PM support will come from. We have the new PM which I am guessing will deal with ECO, but that leaves RO Banding, RO Sus, FITs and RHINI to cover. Seems the right split would be to have Claudine on RHINI and FITs and have another PM to cover RO – but I'm not sure if we have the finance for this, I guess we do as there will be new funding on RHINI and Banding. I will touch base with Andrew who is the LM for PMs.

As regards the other positions I see that we have one and a half Policy Development managers. That would be fine, but I would really like to grab someone from the RHI team for at least one of those positions, so that we have continuity with GBRHI.

From my perspective I am spending 70-80% of my time on FITs at the moment, and that will probably need to remain the case over the next few months if we are to deliver what we need to. However, if we get the right people in at policy development level this should work.

Picking up on your suggestion, I'll put something in our calendars next week for us to discuss.
