1) **Volume 1, Appendix 4** - In NI the European Waste Catalogue is enacted under the List of Wastes (Northern Ireland) Regulations (2005), which includes the EU list as an appendix. We (DETI) don't have an equivalent to the 2006 DEFRA guidance on interpreting the list. This is a policy decision for NIRHI which wastes we allow to be included and subject to us making the same policy decision as DECC, we could use their interpretation of the List of Wastes.

Which list do you wish Ofgem to refer to, the List of Wastes (NI) Regs 2005 or the EU list in the Appendix? Whichever is the answer the guidance ought to reflect the intended approach. Also (if it is to be the DETI list), do DETI wish to acknowledge in the guidance that DECC is the source, as in the GB Regs, or anonymise it. ?

Ollie – pls comment here. I think the use of the Defra list may have been an Ofgem, not DECC, decision, as we simply needed to clarify. Need to be sure what we are trying to achieve, and what we need from DETI vs what we can just decide administratively (can we just decide anything here?) I think
