Hi Michelle,
Just tried calling.

A few of comments on your draft (the first comment probably the most important):

1. Paragraphs 2.9 and 4.16: these are impact by the open letter we (jess – copied in) have written to the public proposing to make changes to the guidance. It's worth checking this letter on our website and asking Jess when the changes will be made to our guidance as these will impact on the NI RHI guidance
2. Para. 5.42 could just say "solid biomass installations are only eligible if their capacity is below 1MW. See xxx for guidance on what the capacity of the installation is."
3. You could also check the Renewables Obligation Order (Northern Ireland) to see whether CHPQA is relevant to NI RO. Marcus should be able to do this.

I didn't pick lots of detailed comments as I don't have time.

Obviously the biomethane chapter needs work on but it's up to DETI to tell you what to do. Saying 'it might never happen' isn't an option for us.
