We have an expected payment to yourselves of £130k for September, I think this was payment profile was previously discussed with Joanne in regards to development costs. As the figure is over £100k our finance team wanted to confirm that it will take place in September and whether we knew the exact day this would be made.
Would you be able to advise on the expected payment in September (i.e. cost of work undertaken in August) and whether it will be over £100k (best estimate is fine)? Also can you advise on likely date of payment, again estimate would be fine. We have yet to receive invoice for June / July work so assuming payments will be made no earlier than 10th of the month.
