Michelle,
Slight issue of concern that has been raised by stakeholders here relates to the application form and associated instructions, in particular, section 6.2 states that the MCS number should be in the following format: MCS-1234567-A. However, most of the certifications in NI through MCS are by Action Renewables and their format is ARE00XX. I am aware that each certification body has its own prefix, with MCS being the prefix of BRE.

Just want to make you aware of this and highlight that the NI MCS reference numbers are likely to be different in format to the GB numbers. The installers are accredited under MCS it is just that they have received accreditation from Action Renewables that use this different reference.
