ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE NON-DOMESTIC RENEWABLE HEAT INCENTIVE (RHI)

Following discussions between our respective policy teams, some minor changes were needed to the RHI Administrative Arrangements between us, in order to reference the Renewable Heat Incentive Schemes (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015.

For convenience, it seems better to replace the existing 2014 Administrative Arrangements rather than make a second set of 'Amending Arrangements'. The only changes of substance are to include references to the new 2015 Regulations. At the same time a couple of typographic points have also been picked up.

The RHI guidance has been updated to reflect the regulatory changes with collaboration between Ofgem and DETI, and I understand that DETI will publish the updated versions on the NI Direct Website.

I have signed the attached Arrangements on behalf of GEMA and would be grateful if you would sign on behalf of DETI as soon as possible so as to ensure a smooth transition to the regime as amended by the 2015 Regulations.

We will continue to deliver the Non-Domestic RHI in line with these updated Administrative Arrangements.
