Keith,

Please see attached final draft version of the NI RHI Regulations for your consideration.

You will note that, as discussed, we have reverted to the original definition of "building", deleted the definition of "site" and replaced references to "site" with "building". Also, please note, revisions at Regulation 51 regarding the word "current", this has followed discussion with our Director of Energy, Fiona is content with this revision.

Regarding Regulation 23, our legal advisors have reviewed your comment in relation the use of wording from regulation 8(3)(b) of the FITS Order. We remain content with the current drafting however if you wish for the wording to be revised I would be grateful if you could propose alternative drafting for our legal advisors to review. Otherwise I would suggest the drafting remains as it stands.

Finally, our legal advisors are checking the most recent query re "NIRO" definition, as per Michelle's email of 19/09. I will revert on this
