Thanks for this. I attach a further copy of the Table, showing with track changes my suggested amendments and, in bold, my comments. You will see that in a number of cases I've suggested that the item concerned should be given a higher priority by DECC. I realise that we've touched on that issue before and that my views as to timing haven't been entirely congruent with those of the development team. I also appreciate that decisions taken as to this may now be set in stone. However it's been a while since I looked at this Table and it seems to me that I ought to flag up even now those items where I feel the priority should be high.

As regards the legal Table, which I sent through some time ago to DECC Legal, do you know whether they will be actioning those amendments as well and if so when? When I sent the Table to the DECC lawyer Irrelevant information redacted by the RHI Inquiry she replied that she would pass it on to the lawyer who would be drafting the amending Regs, but I've heard nothing further.
