Good morning Katy

We have now received further advice from our Solicitors on our draft amendment regulations which we are now working through and we will share a revised draft with you over the next few days. However, on the issue of CHP our Solicitors have not given any specific direction at this stage as they are viewed as technical matters to be resolved between DETI and Ofgem. With that in mind it would be helpful I think for us to work closely with you in arriving at wording which we can both be content with and which fully addresses the issue.

In taking that forward it would be useful if, by return we had your thoughts on possible amendments required to Regulation 9 to satisfy Ofgem's requirements around operating the new CHP tariffs. We can then discuss further and incorporate in our revised draft Regulations?
