Hi Joe,

Have we reached any further position on how we are to address component plants?

I have received the attached enquiry from my contact on the Northern Ireland scheme. A stakeholder is asking about using multiple plants in a single building. They would be hydraulically separate but would heat the same space.

Would the multiple plants be considered a single plant and therefore a single RHI application at the lower tariff? Or would they be multiple plants for which we would accept multiple applications at the higher tariff?

Historically we have accepted multiple applications for multiple plants heating the same space as long as they are hydraulically separate. However, your attached guidance indicates that if boilers are heating the same space they should be considered the same plant. This seems to be the advice the NIRHI contact has given the enquirer.

Does your guidance represent our position now?
