Hi both,
Sorry to ask another NI related question! As you know, DfE have asked us to provide a range of data and information to support their independent review and we aim to send this across in the morning via GSI. Our approach is to be as helpful as possible on the basis we are open and transparent and deliver the scheme on their behalf. However, some of the requests (including data relating to participants' meter readings) are not specifically listed in the data sharing protocol. However, paragraph 3.2 of the admin arrangements provides for us to provide DETI/DfE with (i) such information as is necessary to enable DETI to carry out in a proper manner the powers and duties imposed on DETI by regulations 47(1)(a) and 50; and (ii) such other information as DETI may reasonable request which GEMA may hold in relation to the Conferred Functions.
In your view, does this enable us to provide meter reading data.
