I mentioned before - Stephen Moore was on leave last week and has been in Europe this week. I think he is back in the office tomorrow – so Peter will set up the meeting. However, I do have some concerns about the recent e-mails on the CT issue – they appear to be going back on what was previously agreed i.e. that those who were in receipt of CT loans would receive the RHI on the basis of 'de minimis' aid. Is that not the basis on which you made payment to Mr McConnell? We are certainly not happy with all you are suggesting but a discussion is probably the best way forward.

In terms of data sharing, it is our view that we should be entitled to any information provided by the applicant in support of their application. We can't really anticipate exactly what we might require on an ad hoc basis in the future although you will have an idea of the types of information we have asked for over the last year. Our point is more that when we need RHI information, we need you to be able to provide it. In terms of regular data, the following would be helpful

- Name of applicant
- Postcode
- Type of business/premises/SIC code
- Type of technology
- Installed capacity
- Status of application

I have put in a bid for the admin costs you outlined for 2014/14. I note you will send across a change control shortly to cover the new methodology and that the costs will be reviewed on a regular basis throughout the year.

This is my last day in the office. There is no replacement as yet but hopefully someone will be in post within the next few weeks and will be in touch with you. You should therefore liaise with Peter in the meantime. However, Peter is moving on too and will be leaving on 15 May.
